

RE: Toxoplasma antibody orders

Toxoplasma IgG (convalescent titer) and Toxoplasma IgM (acute titer) antibody tests are now available in-house at Care New England, performed at Women & Infants Lab. Toxoplasma IgG and toxoplasma IgM tests may be ordered individually in EPIC or Cerner to allow for flexibility in meeting specific patient needs. As always, a single equivocal/positive result should be interpreted in light of all clinical information.

For pregnant patients, <u>Toxoplasma IgG test with reflex to IgM</u> is recommended. For confirmation of toxoplasmosis in pregnancy, sera repeatedly positive/equivocal for *T gondii* IgM antibodies may be sent to a Toxoplasma reference laboratory as recommended by the FDA*.
